## JAPAN

- Japanese soldiers went on a rampage of murder and rape, they did not consider the Chinese as "people."

## GERMANY

Why did Goebbels want to create a "people's radio"?

- plan was to get people listening to Nazi broadcasts over the radio

How did Goebbels and the Nazi government try to control public knowledge?

- took over radio stations and newspapers, shut down those that were critical of the Nazis
- burned "un-German" books

What was Kristallnacht?

- co-ordinated attack on Jewish homes, synagogues, businesses; Jews sent to concentration camps
